Doors open 8.45am until 8.55am.



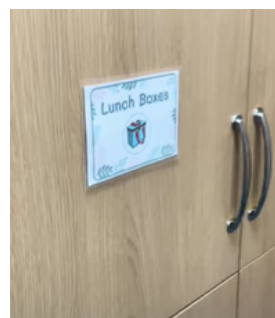
You will come in through this door on the Key Stage 1 playground.

- Lunchbox (if your child isn't having a school lunch).

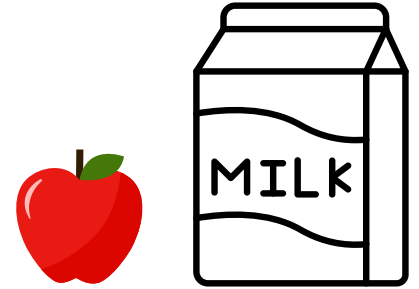
Snacks & lunch

Once you have signed up, you will then need to await to be added to our school directory.



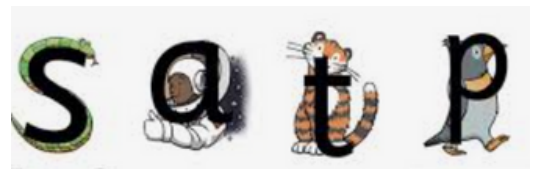
